Principal Advisory Council Summary
August 24, 2021 7:15 – 8:00am

Key Actions:

1. The Chamblee High School Principal Advisory Council elected the following: Chair: D. Martin-Gerstle, Vice-Chair: A. Milne, Secretary: K. Feaster.
2. CHS PAC will meet monthly, the second Tuesday of each month of the school year.
3. All CHS PAC members must complete DCSD offered training.
4. Once training is complete, the CHS PAC may choose to add a committee or additional PAC member(s) to provide continuity on the FSA and ESA scores review and feedback process.
5. CHS PAC to submit Celebrations & Concerns for the upcoming Region 1 PAC Chairs meeting. Celebration: Kudos to students for following mask mandates; Concerns:
a) Capacity of Flex Academy and as that need increases, the potential that the responsibility of teaching students virtually may be pushed to the school level, b) How to prepare and plan the community for what the rising pandemic levels might mean for the schools.

Informational Items:

1. Enrollment is down. Current Enrollment is 1791 with the first weeks' warm body count ranging from 1650-1700. ~30 students attend virtually through Flex Academy. Virtual students are included in the enrollment numbers, but not in the warm body counts. Capacity of the school is 1705, forecasted enrollment was 1874.
2. Staffing is also down and it is challenging to fill these spots in the current environment. Current open positions include: Registrar, Custodian, 2 Social Studies teachers, 2 Special Education teachers, & 2 paraprofessionals.
