



Chamblee High School
Principal Advisory Council Summary
February 8, 2022, 7:15 – 8:00am

Key Actions:

1. The CHS PAC approved the CHS CSIP for the 2021 – 2022 school year.
2. B. Concepcion has resigned due to moving out of the district. After no response from the PAC candidate who received the next highest number of votes in the PAC election from spring 2021, the PAC voted to extend an invitation to the next candidate, K. Logan. If accepted, K. Logan's term will run from now until September.
3. A. Milne will write a proposal to add representatives from SGA and PTSA to the PAC as non-voting members. SGA has requested that this is a rotating group of specific members of SGA.

Informational Items:

1. Ongoing staffing needs exist, particularly custodians. There are also ongoing transportation issues, particularly with one bus route every morning. These are county resources, not school specific resources.
2. DSCD has proposed a new Volunteer Policy. The new policy includes 3 levels of volunteers. Level 1 – No contact with students, and therefore no background check required. Level 2 – Supervised contact with students and background check required. Level 3 – Un-Supervised contact with students (ex. overnight field trip chaperones) and background check required. In the PAC discussion all agreed with the policies for Level 1 & Level 3. There was not a consensus for Level 2 volunteers and whether background checks should be required. Most would like to ensure that valuable members of our community would not be deterred due to cost, transportation needs to the DCSD Security office, fear as an undocumented individual and other issues. All agreed that the current process to complete a volunteer background check was difficult, due primarily to cost and transportation for 2 trips to Security office. This feedback will be passed on in the district-wide PAC meeting to discuss this policy.
3. Members of the CHS PAC have met with members of the Ashford Park PAC. The APS PAC has conducted a survey of their community and over 90% of respondents are opposed to the CMP proposal to move Ashford Park from the Chamblee cluster to the Cross Keys cluster.
